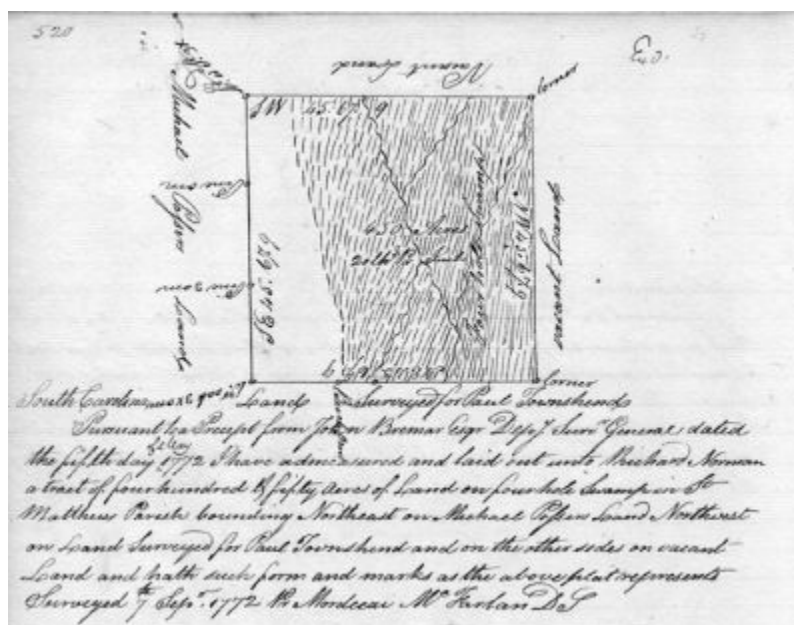

Pursuant to a Precept from John Breinar Esqr Depy Survr General [Deputy Surveyor General] dated the fifth day of May 1772 [05 May 1772] I have admeasured and laid out unto **Richard Norman** a tract of four hundred & fifty [450] acres of Land on four hold Swamp in St. Matthews Parish bounding Northeast on **Michael Posser's** Land Northwest on Land Surveyed for **Paul Townshend** and on the other sides on vacant Land and hath such form and marks as the above plat represents
